About the College

Gandhi Faiz-e-Aam College has earned its strong academic reputation by getting reward as college with potential for excellence by UGC, New Delhi. It was established in the year of independence (1947) by Khan Bahadur Fazl-Ur-Rahman Khan. Presently, it is distinctive among institutions of higher learning and has turned into third largest college of Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Rohilkhand University, Bareilly.

The Department of Zoology was established in 1947 with a limited number of faculty and facilities. During the last 70 years, the department has made all round progress and has acquired position as leading departments of the college. It offers undergraduate (B.Sc.) and postgraduate (M.Sc.) degrees programme. The intake capacity of the students per year is about 500 at undergraduate and 30 at postgraduate level and syllabus of these courses is based on UGC guidelines. Moreover, the department comprises of five permanent and two self finance faculty members with five non-teaching staff. The department is also engaged in research and is guiding PhD and PDF students. The museum of the department is well stocked with various specimens belonging to all the animal phyla which are used for teaching invertebrates and vertebrates. Some rare specimen including skeleton of snake, fish, monkey and human (original) are also kept in museum to know the anatomy of the body.

About the City

The district Shahjahanpur was established in 1813 and before its creation, it was a part of district Bareilly. Geographically, it is situated at 27.35 N latitude and 79.37 E longitudes with 4575 Sq geographical area. This is an agriculture based district surrounded by Ramganga, Garrah and Gomti rivers.

The city came into the spotlight during the Indian struggle for freedom by heroic contribution of Pandit Ram Prasad Bismil, Thakur Roshan Singh and Ashfaqulla Khan and thereafter is known as "Town of Martyrs". The city is situated between Lucknow and New Delhi on NH-24. The adjoining areas of conference interest are Dudhwa National Park (111 Km), Kishanpur Forest Range (65 Km), Pilibhit Tiger Reserve (115 Km), UP Council of Sugarcane Research (2 Km), Kribhco Shyam Fertilizer (13 Km), K.R. Paper and Pulp Industry (10 Km), Reliance Thermal Power (10 Km), Rosa Sugar Works (4 Km), Mcdowell Distillery (4 Km) and Ordinance Clothing Factory (1 Km).
