The study was based on the data collected through a comprehensive field survey conducted for 200 households in Gandhi camp Okhla, Indira colony Shalimar Bagh, Balmiki Kabristan ITO, Meharchand Market Lodhi Road. The major findings of the study is that the inhabitants of the slum facing problems like inadequate water supply ,poor condition of drainage system which causes several diseases and sanitation facilities also reflect poor condition, no proper system of disposal of garbage ,roads also shows bad scenario.
